

	<b>BONNIE BEST, 72 DAYS</b> Famous old canning tomato from Alabama. Medium-sized fruit are round, red, meaty and loaded with flavor. A good producer that makes a fine slicer too. Heirloom.
	<b>CURRENT SWEET PEA, 62 DAYS</b> Tomatoes resemble ruby jewels! Produce large, wispy plants that yield lots of 1/4-inch, deep red, currant tomatoes with rich, complex sweet flavor. Heirloom.
	<b>SUNPEACH, 60 DAYS</b> Sister variety to Sun Gold. Very sweet with excellent flavor. Deep pink, shiny cherries are borne on long trusses. Vigorous, healthy. Indeterminate hybrid.
	<b>RED ROBIN, 55 DAYS</b> Produces good yields of extra sweet red cherry tomatoes. This small plant is perfect for pots and containers and can grow indoors. Determinate hybrid.



	<b>SWEET BANANA, SWEET 68 DAYS</b> Elongated 6" fruit turn scarlet when fully ripe but stay sweet and mild. A longtime favorite for flavor. Delightful in salads or pickled. Heirloom.
	<b>MERLOT, SWEET 68 DAYS</b> Rich, jewel-toned, 5x4" blocky fruit with eye appeal. Crisp, thick walls with very sweet flavor. High yielding plants mature early. Adaptable. Hybrid.
	<b>HOT PORTUGAL, HOT 65-75 DAYS</b> Very hot, thin, red and glossy when ripened. Elongated, curved fruits that can extend 7" or more in length. Can harvest and use at green and red stage. Heirloom.
	<b>GARDEN SUNSHINE, SWEET 80-100 DAYS</b> Productive, dependable pepper. Creamy yellow fruits hold for weeks on the short 12-16" plants, before turning to orange and then red. Heirloom.
	<b>HUNGARIAN HOT WAX, HOT 58-83 DAYS</b> Yellow with 5 1/2" x 1 1/2" smooth, waxy fruits tapering to a point. Easy to stuff and to peel after roasting; thick-fleshed for frying. Heirloom.
	<b>ISLANDER, SWEET 56 DAYS</b> Light lavender skin, pale yellow flesh, 3-lobed, medium-size, thick-fleshed peppers with a mild, slightly sweet taste. Strong plants yield well. Hybrid.
	<b>ANTOHI ROMANIAN, SWEET 53-78 DAYS</b> Eastern European frying pepper. Smooth, 4" by 2" wide, tapered pointed fruits are pale yellow and ripen red. Heavy yield. Heirloom.

	<b>KING OF THE NORTH, SWEET 70 DAYS</b> Arguably the best chance for a red color phase for northern gardeners where seasons are cool and short. Blocky fruits, great sweet flavor. Heirloom.
	<b>LIPSTICK, SWEET 53-73 DAYS</b> Heavy, attractive, dark green fruits are about 4" long and taper to a blunt point. They ripen to a glossy, rich red. Thick, juicy, and sweet. Hybrid.
	<b>CAYENNE LONG SLIM, HOT 73 DAYS</b> Long, slender, slightly wrinkled 4-6" peppers no thicker than a pencil. Very hot. Fruits turn from dark green to bright red. Heirloom.
	<b>AURORA, HOT 60-75 DAYS</b> Small 10-12" plants with tapered fruits 1 1/2". Upright fruiting habit, ripens from lavender to purple to orange and finally to red. Great container variety. Heirloom.
	<b>CARMEN, SWEET 60-80 DAYS</b> A beautiful pepper of the Italian "bull's horn" type. Has a lovely, sweet taste for salads and roasting. Tapered fruits, 6x2.5" ripens green to red. Hybrid.
	<b>FAT-N-SASSY, SWEET 75 DAYS</b> Customer favorite. Big, heavy, thick walled, 4-lobed bells that have excellent flavor. Great for stuffing. Fruit size of 4.5 inches. Heavy yields. Hybrid.
	<b>MINI RED BELL, SWEET 60 DAYS</b> Tiny red bell peppers are only 1.5" tall and wide. Thick red flesh is very sweet and great for stuffing. Heirloom.

	<b>ACE, SWEET 50-70 DAYS</b> Amazing yields of medium 3 to 4-lobed, green bells. Turns red early. Commonly produces heavy crops for Northern growers. Hybrid.
	<b>SHEEPNOSE PIMENTO, SWEET 70-80 DAYS</b> Pimento-shaped fruits are 3" deep and 4" round. Flavorful, sweet thick juicy flesh. Very meaty, good for canning and fresh eating. Heirloom.
	<b>SWEET CHOCOLATE, SWEET 58-78 DAYS</b> Remarkable earliness, tolerance of cool nights, and a heavy set. Smooth, medium-small, tapered, "snub nose" bells. Mild flavor, flesh is brick red. Heirloom.
	<b>EARLY JALEPEÑO, HOT 60-80 DAYS</b> 2 to 2 1/2" x 1" sausage-shaped, blunt fruits that mature early. Dark green fruit changes to red if long enough season. Heirloom.
	<b>HAVASU SANTE FE, HOT 60-80 DAYS</b> Heavy yielding, conical fruits are thick walled, avg. 3 1/2" x 2", and change from a pale yellow to orange to red. Usually harvested yellow. Heirloom.
	<b>THAI, HOT 70-85 DAYS</b> Originally from Thailand, this seriously hot pepper makes a lovely impression in a patio container. Up to 200 small 1/2 -1" fruits. Heirloom.
	<b>TEQUILA SUNRISE, SWEET 75 DAYS</b> Ornamental plant with delicious firm fruit. 5" carrot shaped ripen from deep green to a golden orange. Study plants. Heirloom.

**CARROTS: 50 Seeds / SUMMER & WINTER SQUASH, ZUCCHINI, CUCUMBERS, WATERMELONS, PUMPKINS: 6 Seeds / SWISS CHARD, BEETS, BEANS: 25 Seeds**

- \* **RED-CORED CHANTENAY CARROT:** Heirloom carrot with thick red-orange stumped roots with excellent carrot flavor. Does well in heavy soils. Dependable! 70 days.
- \* **SCARLET NANTES CARROT:** Old-time favorite with bright orange roots. Sweet with small core and medium top. 6.5 x 1.25 in size. 68 days.
- \* **DANVERS CARROT:** Produces conical red-orange roots that taper to a point. Easier to grow in heavier soils than carrots with refined point. Great for cooking. 75 days.
- \* **NORTHERN LIGHTS SWISS CHARD:** Beautiful, colorful mix of chard varieties in shades of magenta, yellow, red, orange and greens. Fun chard variety to grow! 55 days.
- \* **RUBY RED SWISS CHARD:** Lovely crimson-red stalks with heavily crumpled green leaves. Delicious as baby chard and full-grown. 55 days.
- \* **BULL'S BLOOD BEET:** Heirloom favorite beet, prized for its spectacular, sweet, reddish-purple leaves that intensify in color over time. Root is deep delicious red. 60 days.
- \* **DETROIT DARK RED BEET:** Popular beet with full, deep red globe with dark green tops. Introduced in 1892 and still the standard for home gardeners. 58 days.
- \* **CHIOGGIA BEET:** Italian heirloom sometimes called 'Candy Stripe' due to its distinguished alternating concentric rings of scarlet red and white inside. Mild taste. 60 days.
- \* **ZUCCHINI ELITE:** An extra-early high yielding green zuke with a classic cylindrical, slim shaped fruit. Consistent performance. Delicious fried or baked. 48 days.
- \* **BENNING'S GREEN TINT SCALLOP SQUASH:** Uniform greenish-cream scallop squash. One of the best tasting squash varieties, especially when picked young. 55 days.
- \* **YELLOW CROOKNECK SUMMER SQUASH:** Bright yellow bulbous shape, narrow curved neck. Don't let the warts mess with you; it's lovely with excellent flavor! 58 days.
- \* **GREY ZUCCHINI:** Grayish-green summer squash with cream mottling. 5-7" squash. Flesh if firm, mild and tasty! Productive squash. 61 days.
- \* **SUNBURST YELLOW SCALLOP SQUASH:** All American Selection winner. 2.5x3" bright yellow scallop squash. Compact bush is productive! Beautiful fruit. 50 days.
- \* **GOLD RUSH SUMMER SQUASH:** All American Selection winner. Deep gold, upright plant that produces straight uniform fruit with light ridges and smooth skin. 53 Days.
- \* **EIGHT BALL ZUCCHINI:** All American Selection winner. Unique dark-green zucchini in shape of ball. Round shape is speckled. Great for stuffing! Fun squash. 42 days.
- \* **WALTHAM BUTTERNUT WINTER SQUASH:** Elegant tan fruit, orange flesh and sweet nutty flavor. Long season is needed but so rewarding. Can eat before ripe. 105 days.
- \* **SUNSHINE WINTER SQUASH:** Spectacular scarlet color with sublime eating quality. Flesh is dry but tender, sweet yet meaty real substance. Short-vined plants. 95 days.
- \* **VEGETABLE SPAGHETTI WINTER SQUASH:** Yellow flesh is stringy and thin with wonderful, nutty flavor. Use as a "noodle" in meals. Fruits are large, 8-9." 90 days.
- \* **TAY-BELLE ACORN WINTER SQUASH:** Heart-shaped and dark green to jet black in color. Shorter vine can be planted in higher density spacing. Early squash. 70 days.
- \* **THELMA SANDER'S WINTER SQUASH:** Wonderful Missouri heirloom, cream-colored acorn squash with sweet chestnut flavor. 90 days.
- \* **STRAWBERRY CROWN WINTER SQUASH:** A Brazil heirloom. Beautiful brown bi-color squash with a blush of salmon at the crown. Fruits average 6 pounds. 90 days.
- \* **HONEY BEAR ACORN WINTER SQUASH:** All American Selection winner. Delicious, 4" round mini-acorn with delicious starchy and sweet flavor. 85 days.
- \* **RED KURI WINTER SQUASH:** Popular squash with attractive orange-red skin. Yellow and creamy flesh is very sweet and nutty. Grows vigorously and is productive. 85 days.
- \* **CARNIVAL WINTER SQUASH:** Beautiful acorn squash with kaleidoscope of colors, flecked with yellow, green and white. Nutty squash with full-bodied sweetness. 85 days.
